SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Authors are invited to submit original, unpublished research papers and case studies aligned with the conference theme “Transforming Higher Education: Accessibility, Inclusion, Digital Education and Global Partnerships for an Equitable Future.” Submissions will undergo a double-blind peer-review process.

Paper Types

- Full Research Papers: 5,000 – 8,000 words
- Case Studies: 2,000 – 4,000 words

(Word count includes references, tables, and appendices.)

Formatting & Style

- Citation & Formatting Style: APA 7th Edition
- Font: Times New Roman, 12-point
- Line Spacing: 1.5
- Margins: 1 inch on all sides
- Alignment: Justified

Abstract

Each submission must include an abstract of 200–300 words, clearly outlining:

- Purpose and objectives of the study
- Research methodology
- Key findings
- Practical and theoretical implications

Include 4–6 keywords immediately after the abstract.
